## RE: Accounting Policy and Procedure Manual Changes Human Trafficking Prevention Training

## PLEASE PASS THIS INFORMATION TO THE APPROPRIATE PERSONNEL

Pursuant to <u>lowa Administrative Code (IAC) 80.45A</u>, beginning January 1, 2022, all in-state lodging providers must complete the Department of Public Safety's Human Trafficking Prevention Training certification to receive public funds for State employee lodging, conferences, meeting, banquets, or any state-funded event. All of the lodging provider's employees must complete the training to be certified. If a lodging provider is not certified, public funds cannot be used for travel reimbursement or any other expense.

A <u>temporary</u> copy is available for your review. Once effective, it will replace the current policy in the Accounting Policy and Procedures Manual and be removed from this location.

Below is a summary of changes to Procedure 210.205 in the DAS-SAE Accounting Policy and Procedure Manual, which reflects the above information. This policy becomes effective, January 1, 2022.
