## Roadmap to the W-4

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Step 1 and 5 are required.

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If only step 1 is completed, withholding will be based on the standard deduction according to the filing status.

(Single or married filing separately, married filing jointly or head of household) and tax rates with no other adjustments.

Completing Step 2 through 4 are **optional** and when applicable, will result in more accurate withholding.

Step 2 (c) will **INCREASE** withholding based on additional jobs held or a working spouse.

Step 3 line 3 and Step 4 line 4(b) will **DECREASE** withholding based on dependent and deduction information provided.

Step 4 Line 4(a) will **INCREASE** withholding based on nonwage income indicated.

Step 4 Line 4(c) will **INCREASE** withholding based on requested additional withholding.
