Subject	CENTRAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES – HUMAN RESOURCES ENTERPRISE WORKERS' COMPENSATION		

1. By the authority of Section 19A.32 of the Code of Iowa, the Department of Administrative Services-Human Resources Enterprise (DAS-HRE) adjusts all claims of state employees for workers' compensation benefits pursuant to Sections 85, 85A, 85B, and 86. A state employee workers' compensation fund is established to pay such approved claims.
2. By the authority of Section 19A.32 of the Code of Iowa, the Workers' Compensation Section of the DAS-HRE has established a rating formula to assess premiums to all departments and divisions of the State including those which have not received an appropriation for the payment of workers' compensation insurance and which operate from moneys other than from the general fund of the State. The DAS-HRE collects the premiums through invoicing annually
