Vehicle Opportunities

Deery of Ames now has passenger vans for 12 or 15 people on State contract. These are Ram ProMasters and the lead time is 16-18 weeks. The total cost is \$85,423.60. 79 units are available.

DAS Fleet also has immediate availability of four Ram ProMaster City cargo vans for departments to purchase. These are small cargo vans offered on a first-come-first-served basis for \$34,925. Ram has discontinued this vehicle in the US. Ford and Chevrolet have also discontinued their vehicles with similar size and capability (Transit Connect and City Express, respectively)
