# I. Purpose

**A.** The purpose of this policy is to inform drivers of the vehicle size and type indicated for the number of passengers a vehicle will have during use for State business.

### II. Policy

**A.** Under normal social distancing guidelines, in order to maximize efficiency and minimize costs, the State of Iowa policy for vehicle classifications will be adhered to for the number of passengers as outlined in IAC <u>11-103.4</u>.

# III. Procedure

#### A. Guidelines

- 1. Compact vehicle category: 1-2 passengers
- 2. Mid-size vehicle: 3 or more passengers
- **3.** Full size vehicle: 4 or more passengers
- **4.** Minivan: 3 or more passengers
- **5.** Cargo Van: shall be appropriate in size and GVWR for their primary use with regard to payload and cargo volume.
- **6.** 8-Passenger Van: 5 or more passengers.
- **7.** 12-Passenger Van: 7 or more passengers.
- **8.** 15-Passenger Van: 9 or more passengers.
- **9.** Pickups and SUVs: shall be appropriate in size, GVWR, and drivetrain (two-wheel or four-wheel drive) for their primary use with regards to trailering, payload, cargo volume, and on/off road equipment.
