Dear Janet,

HSEMD is requesting your approval for an administrative rules waiver.

ADMINISTRATIVE RULE TO BE WAIVED: IAC11-118.16(3)

STATEMENT OF THE RULE:

118.11(3) A service contract should be competitively selected on a regular basis so that a state agency obtains the best value for the funds spent, avoids inefficiencies, waste or duplication and may take advantage of new innovations, ideas and technology. A service contract, including all optional renewals, shall not exceed a term of six years; however, service contracts entered into by the office of chief information officer may have a term length not to exceed ten years. Service contracts shall not exceed the term lengths set forth herein unless the state agency obtains a waiver of this provision pursuant to rule 11—118.16(8A).

CONTRACT NEEDING THIS RULE WAIVER: MB3 Disaster and Emergency Management Portal (contract # 583-2012-HSEMD-034)

TERM OF THE CONTRACT: July 5, 2012 through July 4, 2018

REQUESTED CONTRACT ENDING DATE: July 4, 2020

## **REASONS:**

HSEMD is requesting a waiver of 11-118.16(3) so that the vendor can complete all the scope of work items identified in the original contract and all the associated amendments.

The contract is for professional services in connection with the development and implementation of the EMGrantsPro System (HSEMD's online grant and financial management system), the installation, configuration, customization, and hosting of the

software. HSEMD received all the necessary procurement approvals for the contracts and amendments.

Due to unforeseen circumstances such as changing federal grant requirements, some of the enhancements cannot be completed by July 4, 2018. HSEMD is requesting a twoyear extension to allow for the completion of work as stipulated in contract agreements.
