Dear Director Phipps:

The Department of Human Services (DHS) is seeking a waiver as described in 11 Iowa Administrative Code (IAC) Section 118.16 regarding the contracts for Supervised Apartment Living (SAL).

Specifically, DHS seeks a waiver of the six-year contract limitation set forth in IAC 118.11(3) applicable to service contracts. DHS applies for this waiver because the RFP issued on October 24, 2016 produced unacceptable responses and it is in the best interest of the clients to extend the existing contract for an additional twelve months to complete a new re-procurement process. DHS is actively working on reissuing the RFP and anticipates having new SAL contracts in place within six months, although the 12 months contract extension requested in this letter provides the flexibility that may be needed due to the complexity of reissuing the RFP, evaluating proposals and completing contract negotiations.

The current Supervised Apartment Living contracts were first executed on July 1, 2011 and are set to expire on June 30, 2017. The extension requested is for a maximum period of 12 months, through June 30, 2018.

Please approve a waiver of IAC 118.11(3) on the grounds that it is not in the best interest of the taxpayers to maintain a six-year limit.
