ADMINISTRATIVE RULE WAIVER REQUEST

Due to the restricted conditions performed by on-call DNR staff carrying out certain state and federal laws that protect lowa's air, land, and water, the DNR requests that employees fulfilling Emergency Response duties as described below be eligible for standby pay according to 53.9(3) starting the pay period including July 1, 2019.

Anyone manufacturing, storing, handling, transporting, or disposing of a hazardous substance is required to notify the DNR within 6 hours of hazardous condition occurring. The Administrative rules governing the reporting of hazardous conditions are found in several IAC chapters, including, but not limited to: 567 IAC Chapters 24 (excess air emissions); 42 (public water supply — Tier 1 public notice); 63 (wastewater bypasses) 65 (manure releases), and 131 (hazardous conditions). Also, section 304 of the federal Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA) establishes emergency release notification requirements if there is a release to the environment of a hazardous substance.

The DNR maintains a 24/7 Environmental Emergency Reporting Hotline for the reporting of hazardous conditions. Over the past three years, more than 40% of the 2,500+ hazardous conditions reported to the DNR were received outside of normal business hours during on-call periods.

The current staffing and procedures for the DNR Environmental Emergency Reporting were developed from a series of process improvement events. The following restricted conditions occur during an on-call period: employees are expected to remain within close proximity to their assigned region, respond to calls immediately (e.g. provide recommendations for hazard clean-up, notify the public information officer if an immediate press release is needed, research chemical inventory databases, ensure proper HazMat and local officials are notified, etc.), remain sober, and travel to the incident site to provide onsite assistance if it is a hazardous release with potential for significant risk to public health or natural resources. These restricted conditions for emergency response during after-hours are unique to the DNR's Field Services & Compliance Bureau and not performed elsewhere within the DNR. Specialized training and certifications (e.g. 40-hour OSHA HAZWOPER) are required for appropriate and safe handling of hazardous conditions.

The duties outlined above are designed to proactively address environmental hazards before they escalate into larger events with greater public health risk and damage to natural resources. Recent examples include natural disasters (e.g. flooding) that pose immediate threats to drinking water and wastewater facilities; train derailments of hazardous chemicals near major waterways; industrial facility explosions near residential communities; pipeline spills; dam breaches near residential and recreation areas; trucking accidents involving hazardous chemicals; and manure spills resulting in fish kills. There has also been an increased awareness of the potential for terrorist attacks on key infrastructure targets that the DNR is responsible for regulating (e.g. public water supplies, electric utilities, wastewater treatment, etc.).

The DNR has determined that the standby pay requirements established in 53.9(3) are reasonable, appropriate, and cost-effective for these specific work units due to the restricted work expectations.
