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## State Driver Corrective Actions (continued)

Four at fault or preventable accidents during a five-year period while operating a state vehicle - 103.12(3)

Six or more moving violations while operating a state or private vehicle within a three-year period - 103.12(3)

Conviction of more than one OWI within a five-year period while operating a private vehicle on private business - 103.12(3)

Failure to notify the Department of Administrative Services, Fleet Services of an OWI conviction received while operating a state or private vehicle -103.12(3)

Failure to attend or complete a Driver Improvement Course - 103.12(4)

Driving a state vehicle or private vehicle on state business with a suspended driver's license - 103.12(5)

Driving a private vehicle for state business without the minimum insurance required by law - 103.12(5)

Convicted of operating a state vehicle while intoxicated or operating a private vehicle on state business while intoxicated - 103.12(7)

Suspension from driving a State vehicle or private vehicle on State business for a period exceeding one year up to a permanent suspension. Proof of completion of a Driver Improvement Course and proof of insurance required.

Suspended driving privileges until Driver Improvement Course is completed.

Suspended from driving a State vehicle or a private vehicle on State business for up to one year.

Permanent suspension from driving a State vehicle or driving a private vehicle on State business.

- <u>Defensive Driving Courses</u> are conducted online by the NSC.
- Driver Improvement Courses are conducted by area community colleges.
- Drinking Driver Course conducted by the area community college or a licensed substance abuse treatment program as defined in <u>lowa Code 321J.22</u>.
- Substance abuse evaluation and treatment services offered by a licensed substance abuse treatment program as defined in <u>lowa Code 321J.22</u>.
