Series Concept

This series includes positions whose employees train correctional residents in the manufacture of state industry products and delivery of services, as well as positions that coordinate production in state industries product divisions. Additionally, all employees in this series have an ongoing responsibility for enforcing institutional security, safety, sanitation rules and regulations, and for controlling the movement and behavior of correctional residents.

Exclusions

Employees in correctional institutions who perform security, maintenance, trades, and related work outside of a state industries product division.

Class Distinctions

State Industries Technician

This is the entry/full performance level class in the series. Employees in this class are distinguished from the senior technician by virtue of the fact they do not have an assigned responsibility within their assigned division for any of the following: overseeing a specific area of production, assisting a production coordinator or supervisor in the oversight of the operation of a state industries product division, or performing lead work over other State Industries Technicians.

Senior State Industries Technician

Employees in this class have an assigned responsibility for overseeing specific production activities (i.e., a responsibility for a zone, shop, floor, area, etc.), and/or assisting a production coordinator/supervisor in the oversight of the operation of a state industries product division, and/or performing lead work over State Industries Technicians.

State Industries Production Coordinator

Employees in this class either lead two or more technicians and coordinate production activities in one or more state industries product division(s), or are assigned sole responsibility for all of a product division's production, purchasing, financial goals, product development, and deliveries. They generally report directly to a State Industries Supervisor.
